1. Choose which option you would like to use as your accountability.

3. Come up with goals of what you would like to see your child learn and how for each subject.
 - Math
 - Science
 - English (reading/writing or Literature/Composition for Grade 7+)
 - Social Studies
4. Decide if there is something outside of these required classes that you would like your child to learn or they have an interest in.
5. Choose how you would like to keep your records.
